

Building Our Future

Again, we are most fortunate to be able to Match all donations up to \$210,000. The period of the Fall Match is from September 1 – December 10, 2024. The following projects are our focus:

Water Cisterns

Rain-gathering cisterns are desperately needed on many of our school campuses. Water is used for drinking, cooking each school day, and handwashing. Cisterns are the most effective way to collect and store water in the remote mountains. There is skilled know-how in the region and a proven cistern construction model. Each cistern costs approximately \$15,000. Our survey of schools indicates that 17 of our schools do not have cisterns. There are also a number of schools whose cisterns need repairs.



Textbooks for Students

Our students are in great need of updated textbooks for their classes. The subjects that they study are like those our students in the United States study... all levels of math, science, history, language arts, and foreign language. New textbooks will be welcomed by students and teachers alike.

General Scholarship Fund

The GSF remains our "bread-and-butter" resource for the payroll of unsponsored schools and 7th-9th grade programs. This fund also covers occasional ancillary needs to ensure our students get the most from their education.
