The end of the 2025-2026 school year is quickly approaching. This marks our 37th year of providing children with an opportunity to go to school in a very rural part of the world. Founder of the Haiti Education Foundation, Frances Landers, described her first visit to a village without school in this way: “The children were wandering around with bulging eyes and bloated bellies. They were completely without hope or direction.”

The scenery quickly changed once the first school was built. Today, the Haiti Education Foundation family of donors sponsors 34 schools, educating nearly 7,000 students. Welcoming the students to school each day are 650 administrators, teachers, aides, and cooks. Five Episcopalian priests oversee the schools and direct the activities of the churches that meet regularly. Our school communities have been brought from darkness to light over the years. Hope is alive and well in the mountains. YES, we are making a difference each and every day!

Our funding goals are high this year as we focus first on educating the children...and then turn our eyes to continue improving the learning environment. You will see that your contributions are being used in wonderful ways on the following pages. We ask that you continue to support us in prayer and with your giving. To establish an avenue for giving where 100% of contributions go to the need designated by the donor.

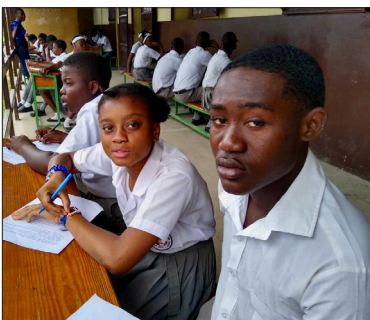

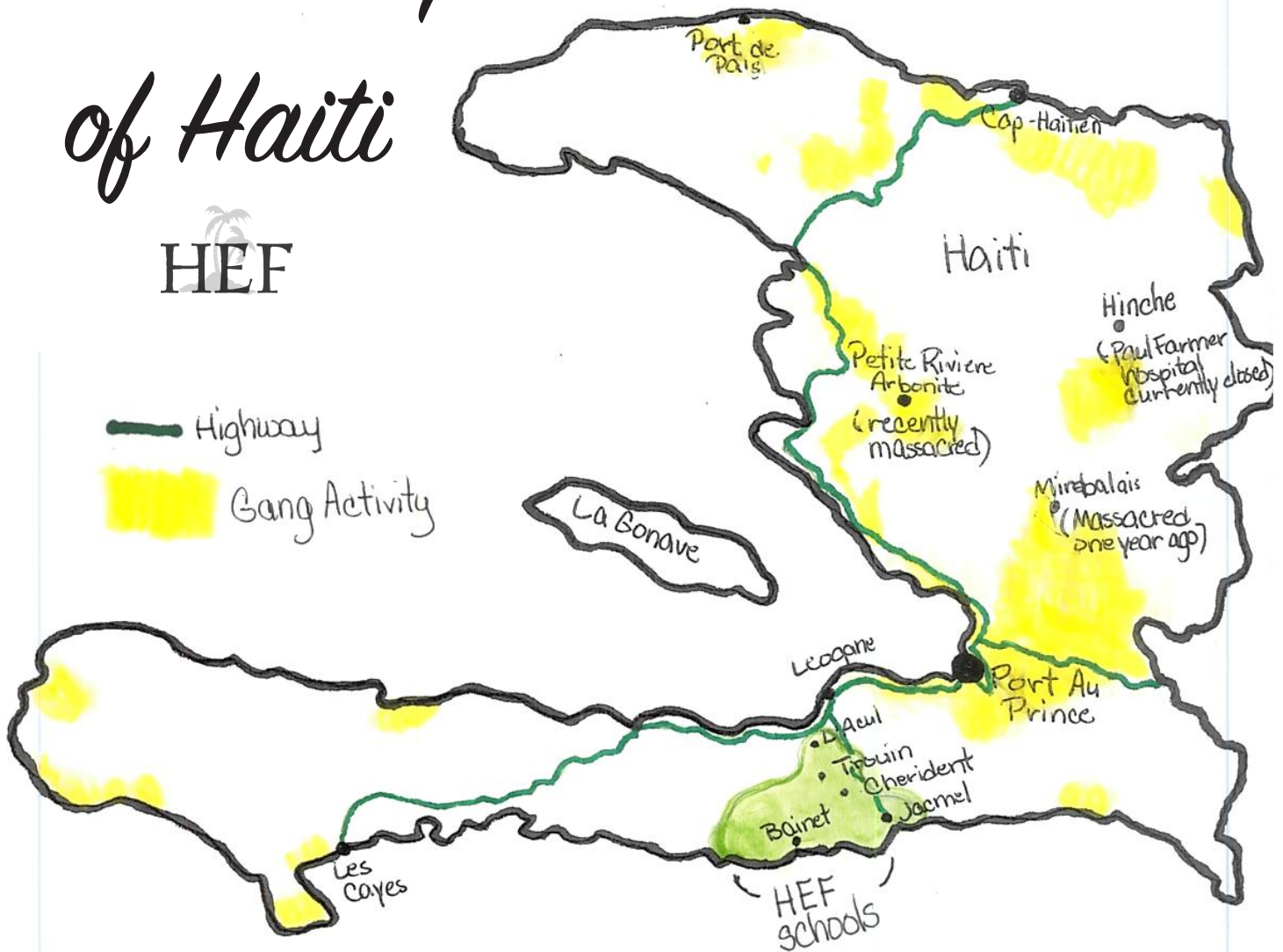


Susan's Map

To give you a general reference of where our schools are located, I thought I would share this map. Note the five villages in the green circled area. The schools that we sponsor are overseen by five Episcopal parish priests. The villages noted are the homes of those five priests.

Pere Delicat lives in L'Acul, which is in Epiphanie Parish.

Pere Mondesir lives in Trouin, which is in St. Marc Parish.

Pere Jacob lives in Cherident, which is in St. Matthias Parish.

Pere Junior lives in Bainet, which is in Ascension Parish.

Pere Luc lives in Jacmel, which is in Christ Roi Parish.

A school is located in each of these villages that is known as the "parish school" and then there are other schools spread throughout the countryside. There are 34 schools in total sponsored by HEF, and most of them are located in the central and south portion of the circled area.

We have shared that the gang problems are mostly in Port-au-Prince and more urban areas. The spread at this point is mainly north of Port-au-Prince. There is some spread to the west, but the locals are vigilant in fighting off the trouble along the highway outside of Leogane.

Construction Updates



St. Marc School, Trouin

This school was built with funds raised in the 2024 Matching Challenge at a cost of \$243,650. At the same time, one of our partnering organizations, Haitian Hope, built a vocational school. The total amount of the project was \$315,035. The project included 13 classrooms, a principal's office, toilette block, water cistern, and security wall. What a blessing for this community and the students who will be educated at this school.

St. Barthelemy School, Bahot

This school is being built with funds raised in the 2025 Matching Challenge at a cost of \$252,580. There will be nine new classrooms, a principal's office, toilette block, water cistern, and security wall. Teachers and children eagerly await its completion which should be in July. Students will begin the 2026/2027 school year in a brand new, safe, building. Another blessed community!



MATCHING FUNDS to \$400,000
through December 10, 2026

To continue to improve our school learning environment, all gifts designated as Construction Funds will be fully matched through December 10, 2026. Our goal of \$400,000 is a hefty one. Please consider a specific gift to help with these exciting projects.

Our 2027 school rebuild will be **St. Barnabe School**, Lavalle, at a cost of \$318,000. This school will have nine rooms and a principal's office, new toilette block, water cistern, and security wall like the others. Other projects covered in the match are roof repairs, construction of additional classrooms, solar panel replacements, and school benches and desks. We want to provide the best we can for the students and teachers in these remote schools.

Ongoing Projects:

Water Cisterns: We have completed repairs on or have built new cisterns on nine campuses since January of 2025. We have 11 more to go. At this time, our team of builders is focusing on roof repairs from Hurricane Melissa.

Roof Repairs: We have completed four roofing repair projects and have four more in progress. There are 19 more projects to be completed. Funding for these repairs is something that is included in the Construction Matching Funds for this year.
